THE MARTINEZ POST-DEPLOYMENT ASSESSMENT TREATMENT PROGRAM IN CALIFORNIA



The Martinez Post-Deployment Assessment Treatment Program, modeled like The Pathway Home, met with Christine and her team just weeks before her death to plan a partnership. Several Pathway graduates have gone through the program, including one who is now a psychologist helping other veterans recover from PTSD. The Foundation’s annual support has helped the program build connections and partnerships between the VA and community groups, Rotary Clubs, and the business and education community.
